Incoming or prospective students

UVSQ emphasizes on the quality of the reception of foreign students thanks to the one-stop counter (information, housing, health, cultural activities, French courses, summer schools). Coming to UVSQ on individual mobility (outside any exchange program)

- » If you **are a student from the European Union**, Iceland, Lichtenstein or Norway, your procedures are the same as those for French students.
- » If you are **not a citizen of the EU**, Iceland, Lichtenstein or Norway, consult the application procedure. If you have a French secondary or higher education diploma, your procedures are the same as those for French students.

Coming to UVSQ on an exchange program

UVSQ has concluded cooperation agreements with more than 200 partner universities around the world in order to develop student mobility. You can come to UVSQ for one year through the Erasmus + program or through another program.

Incoming or prospective PHD students
