DESCRIPTION GÉNÉRALE DU COURS

This course, taught in English, is designed to present the historical and conceptual foundations of the European Union, through its chronology, its institutions, and the legal principles on which the Organization was built. It is structured in two parts. The first part deals with the birth of the Organization, its institutions, its political essence, and its limits; while the second offers an introduction to EU law through recognition of the main principles - the rule of law, democracy and human rights -, the sources of the legal order on which it is based, and the remedies its founding texts provide.

This course is designed to give students a general understanding of the characteristics and the functioning of the European Union. A good level in English is required.
