 greographical locations. You may select more than 3 if you would like. Please follow this guide on how to select universities:
## Step 1: Explore our Partners

Using the micefa website: www.micefa.org/universites-partenaires/ research which universitiy partners interest you based on academic needs and personal preferences. Please consult the list of universities available for you particular exchange period.

## Your selection should be based on the following criteria:

$\checkmark$ Are courses offered in my specialty (are these courses open to exchange students)? Consult the "Etudes possibles par Université "table available on the MICEFA website.
$\checkmark$ Do I have the necessary financial ressources?
$\checkmark$ Do I have the required language level?
$\checkmark \quad$ Is my nationality* eligible? *Ex: American citizens are not accepted by universities in Califomia.

Step 2: Make Your Selection
Select a minium of 3 universities and/or consortiums in accordance with the following rules:
$\checkmark$ Selections must be from 3 distinct geographical regions and can not all be in Canada (maximum 2 universities);
$\checkmark$ If interested in a consortuim (CSU, CUNY, SUNY) each counts as a single wish. You must then select 4 campuses.
$\checkmark$ If interested in a consortium, you may not select both CSU and CUNY. (SUNY + CSU or CUNY is allowed.)
$\checkmark$ Consult University Groups. Selecting only Group A univerisities results in a higher likelihood of being placed outside of your wishes.
