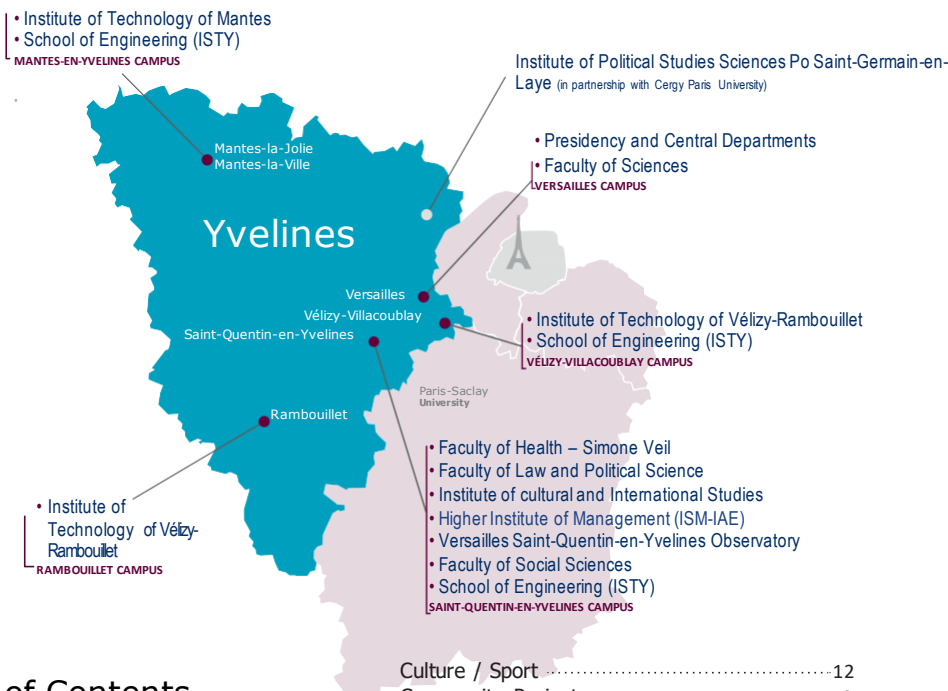

NEW STUDENT AT UVSQ?

When entering at USVQ, you must follow **two mandatory and essential steps**:

- ▶ Complete the **administrative registration** to get the student status and have access to a range of digital services including the Intranet. Remember that the administrative registration step must be completed to enable access to the UVSQ digital platform.
- ▶ Complete the **course registration** to enrol in the mandatory classes of your field of study and choose among the various options, if available.

Log into the online services with the USVQ single sign-on “Sésame”

The Sésame authentication account allows you to have access to digital resources:

- ▶ **your personal file**, which includes your calendars and examination results
- ▶ **your messaging service and collaborative tools** (calendar, portfolio, office software, fileSender...)
- ▶ the educational platform **e-campus**, to make discussions with your teachers easier
- ▶ your university libraries reader account
- ▶ Wi-Fi...

It also allows you to turn on the computers in the IT rooms.

Student file

By opening your file, you will find the following details after that you have completed your administrative registration:

- ▶ **Personal data:** Surname and first names, date of birth, file number, diplomas...
- ▶ Current or permanent address
- ▶ List of all the **registrations you made** at UVSQ
- ▶ Examination **calendar** (dates, rooms, duration)
- ▶ **Marks and results**

You will receive it after your initial registration at the UVSQ. Always keep it from one year to another while at university.

- ▶ With your student status, take advantage of **discounted rates** from UVSQ cultural partners **with the "UVSQ'culture" pass**.
- ▶ Pay for **CROUS** (dining) and university services (printing, photocopy).
- ▶ Have access to some services from Paris-Saclay member institutions (libraries, sporting/cultural activities).
